## **Annapolis Senior Activity Center Trip Rules**

- 1. ALL TRIPS ARE OPEN TO CURRENT SENIOR CENTER MEMBERS.
- 2. Participants must be self-sufficient to go on trips. The Senior Center Manager may require a physician's certification to approve travel.
- 3. Anyone who exhibits inappropriate behavior must be approved by the Senior Center Director before traveling.
- 4. Registration and seat assignments will commence upon receipt of the required deposit. Checks are preferred, no credit cards. Seat assignments will be the responsibility of the Trip Coordinator. If after two weeks you have not paid your deposit, your seat will be released.
- 5. All monies are <u>non-refundable</u> unless a replacement can be found from the waiting list. Certain exceptions will be handled on a case-by-case basis by the Senior Center Staff.
- 6. Participants must provide their own transportation to and from the meeting point.
- 7. Absolutely no smoking or alcoholic beverages on the bus.
- 8. All participants must sign a Release of Liability Form before each trip.
- 9. All trip participants will be issued name tags. These name tags will identify them as members of the group which sponsored the trip. There should also be a phone numbers on the name tags of the Senior Center and the cell phone number of the trip coordinator. In addition, participants should carry an index card with their name, address, and emergency contact. It should also include medical information.
- 10. Buses will not wait for anyone. Participants must adhere to scheduled arrival and departure times. Should you become separated from the group while on a trip, use the information you name tag to call your trip coordinator.
- 11. Participants should stay home & avoid traveling when suffering from communicable illnesses, (e.g. flu, cold, etc.).
- 12. Paticipants should not use strong or excessive fragrances on the bus to avoid causing allergic or other adverse reactions to their fellow trip participants.

### **DEPOSITS/PAYMENTS**

- 1. Seats will be reserved upon receipt of the required deposit. Initial deposits must be made in person during the hours specified on the front page. These hours are subject to change. We will put any changes in the Monthly Activities Schedule and on the web site.
- 2. Once a deposit has been made on a particular trip or trips, you may also mail additional payments. Please address the envelope to: Trip Committee, Annapolis Senior Activity Center, 119 South Villa Avenue, Annapolis, MD 21401. Please specify what trip(s) you are paying for, also include a valid telephone number where you can be contacted, if it is not on your check. Your cancelled check will be your receipt.
- 3. If any special accommodation is needed, it is the responsibility of the traveler to inform the Trip Coordinator at the time of the initial deposit.
- 4. Full payment is due on the specified date. If final payment is not received by the due date, the Trip Committee has the authority to cancel your reservation. It is not the responsibility of the Trip Committee to notify you of the final payment due dates. **Please mark your calendars**.
- 5. All trips include taxes and gratuities.
- 6. Checks are the preferred method of payment. Make payable to ASI. Cash is accepted. No Credit Cards.

#### **Departures/Returns/Parking**

- 1. All trips leave from the Annapolis Senior Activity Center. Because of our location and out of courtesy, trip participants are requested to park at the far end of the parking lot and walk up to the Senior Activity Center.
- 2. The Annapolis Senior Activity Center is not responsible for any vehicle left on the lot.
- 3. Please arrive at least 30 minutes before the bus is scheduled to depart.
- 4. Return times to the Center are approximate. Give yourself some "flexibility" with return times.
