SUMMARY OF SURVEY RESULTS P4525553 – Underused Park

Survey data was collected on the following dates: 10/30/23, 11/30/23 via Constant Contact survey software. Opportunities to participate in the public survey process were posted on DRP's web page and shared on Anne Arundel County Government social media outlets.

The following parks were listed in the survey for consideration:

Bacontown Russett Park, Central Avenue Park, Crofton Park, Jessup Elementary Park, Marley Creek Park, Riva Area Park, Rock Creek Park, Stoney Creek Park, Sullivan Park, West County Park

In the survey, amenities were listed as:

Natural Areas (trails, nature center, gardens, etc.)

Water Access (swimming, fishing pier, kayak launch, etc.) **only Stoney Creek/Sullivan*

Court Sports (basketball, tennis, pickleball, volleyball, street hockey, etc.)

Community Facilities (playground, pavilion, dog park, amphitheater, etc.)

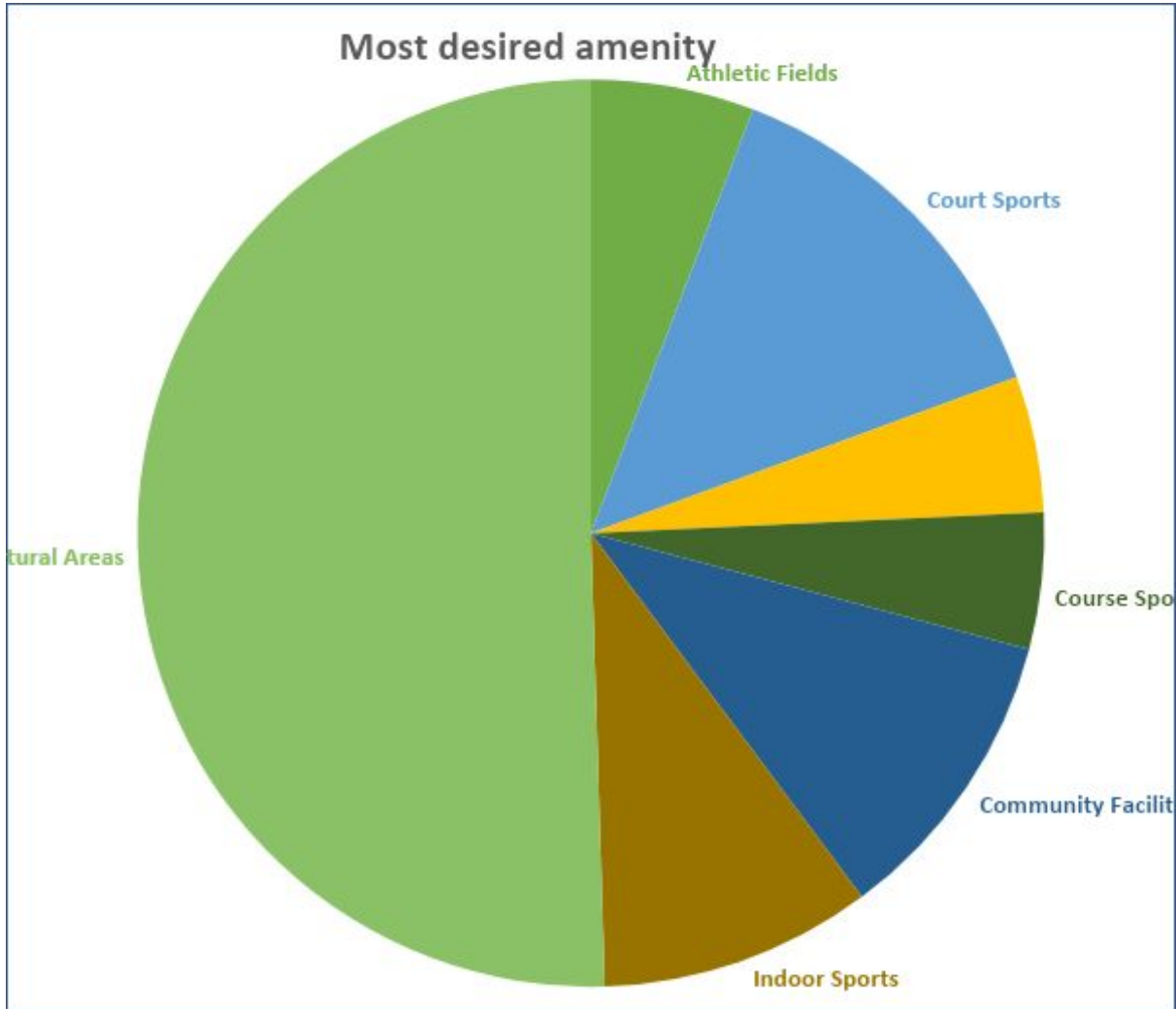
Athletic Fields (multipurpose, baseball, track and field, etc.)

Course Sports (disc golf, skateboarding, BMX, equestrian, etc.)

Adventure Sports (disc golf, skateboarding, BMX, equestrian, etc.)

Indoor Sports (gym, basketball, field sports, ice skating, etc.)

BACONTOWN RUSSETT PARK – 799 survey responses

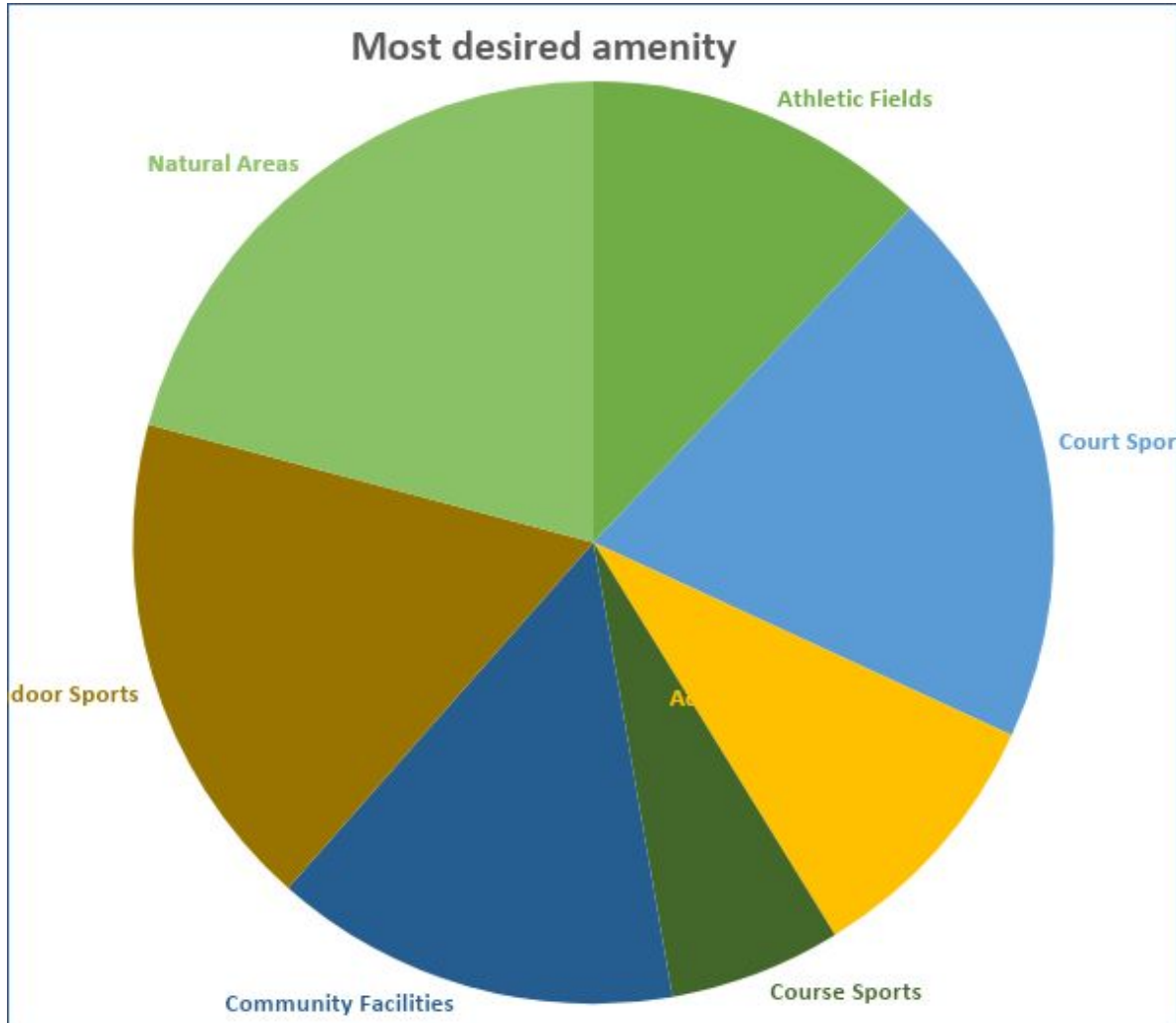

CENTRAL AVENUE PARK – 1,303 survey responses

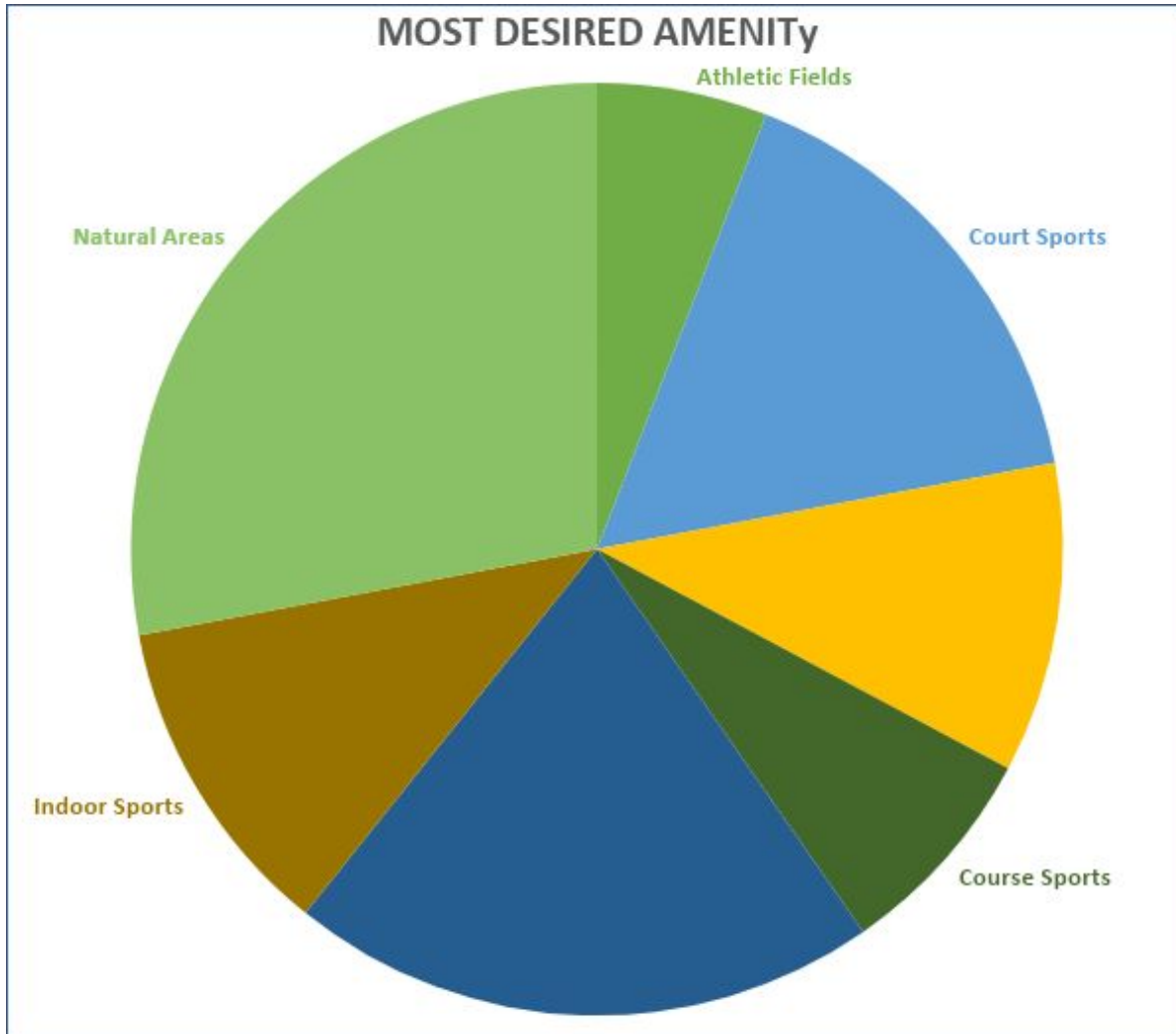

CROFTON PARK – 902 responses

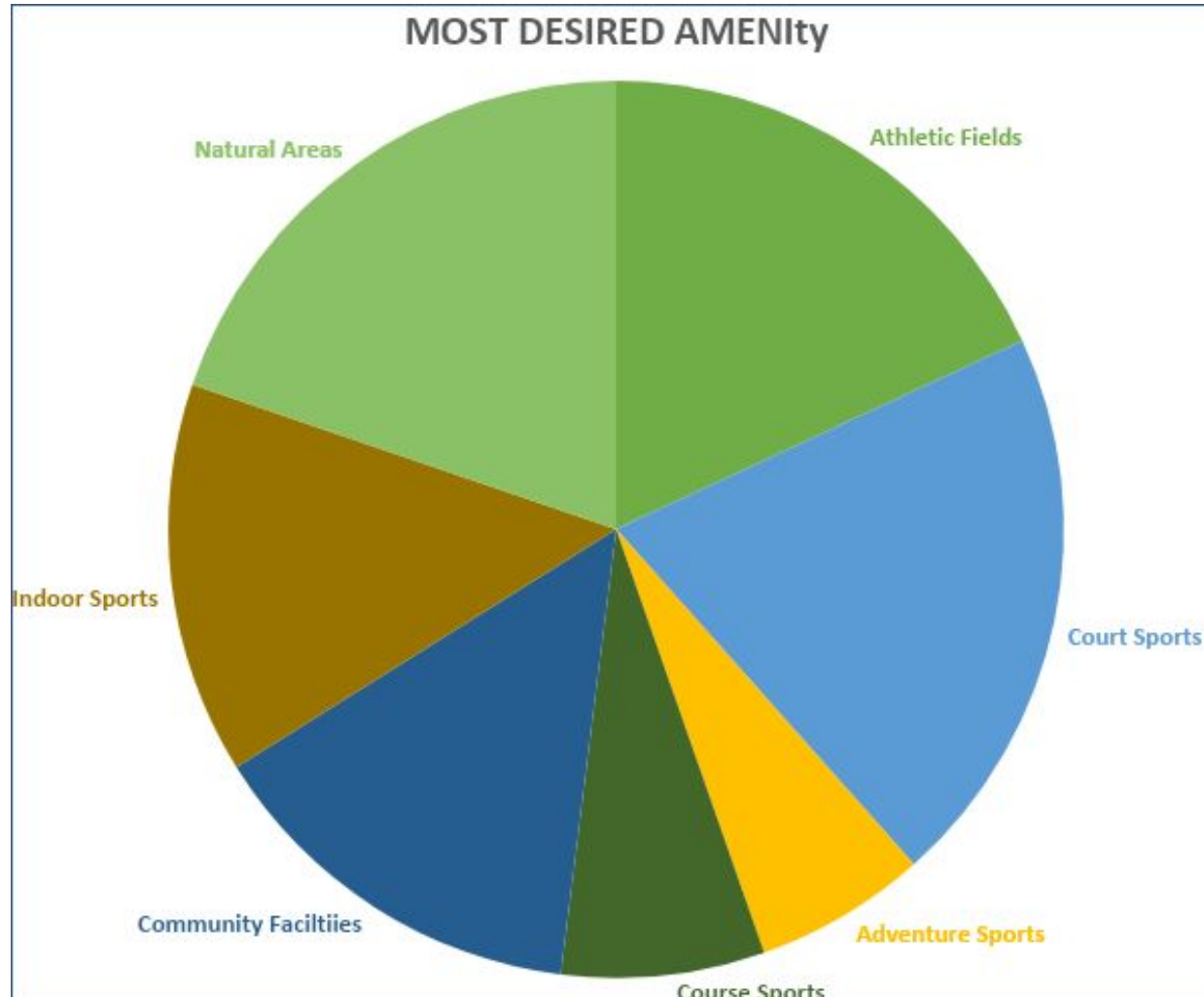

JESSUP ELEMENTARY PARK – 96 responses

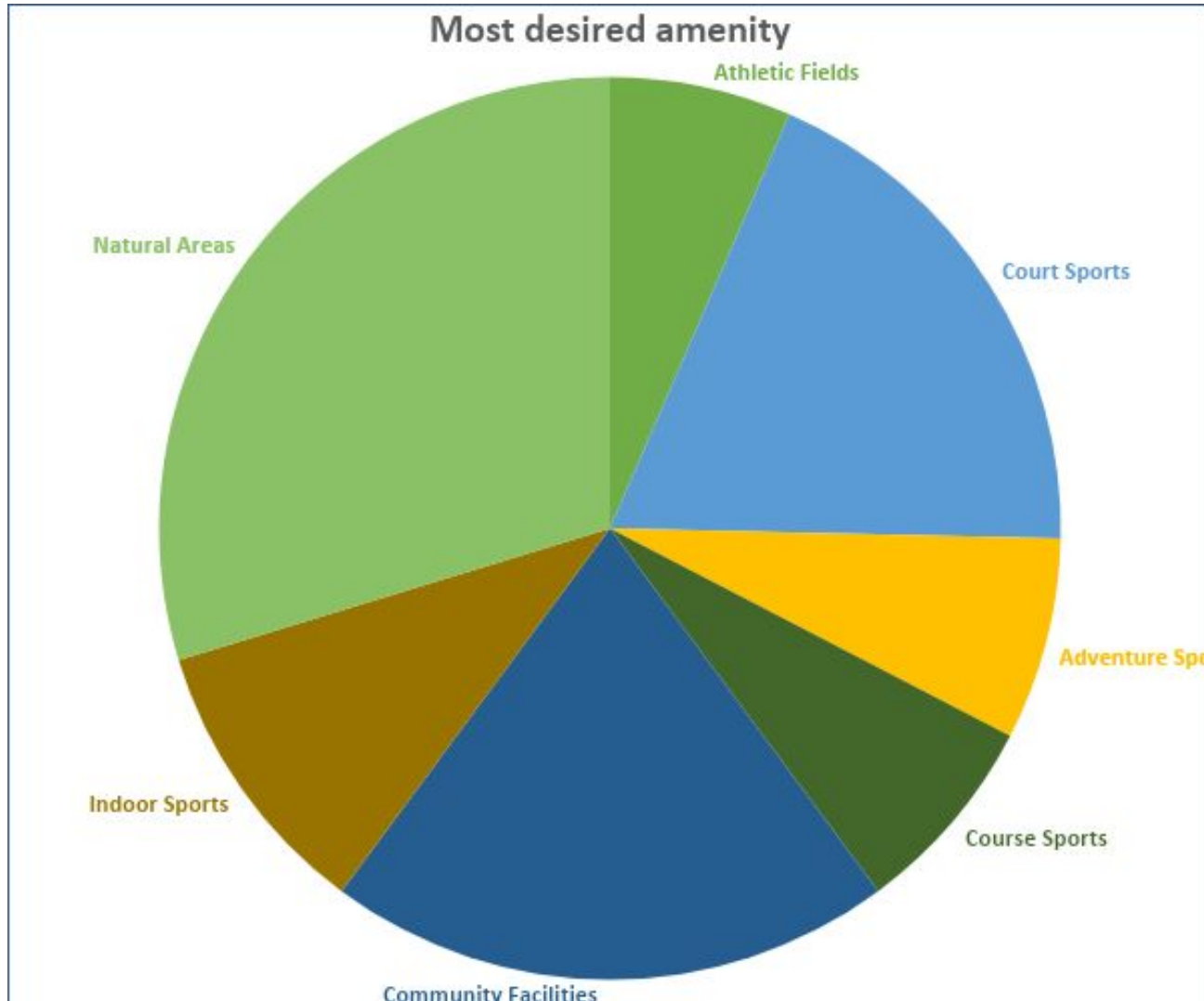

MARLEY CREEK PARK – 400 responses

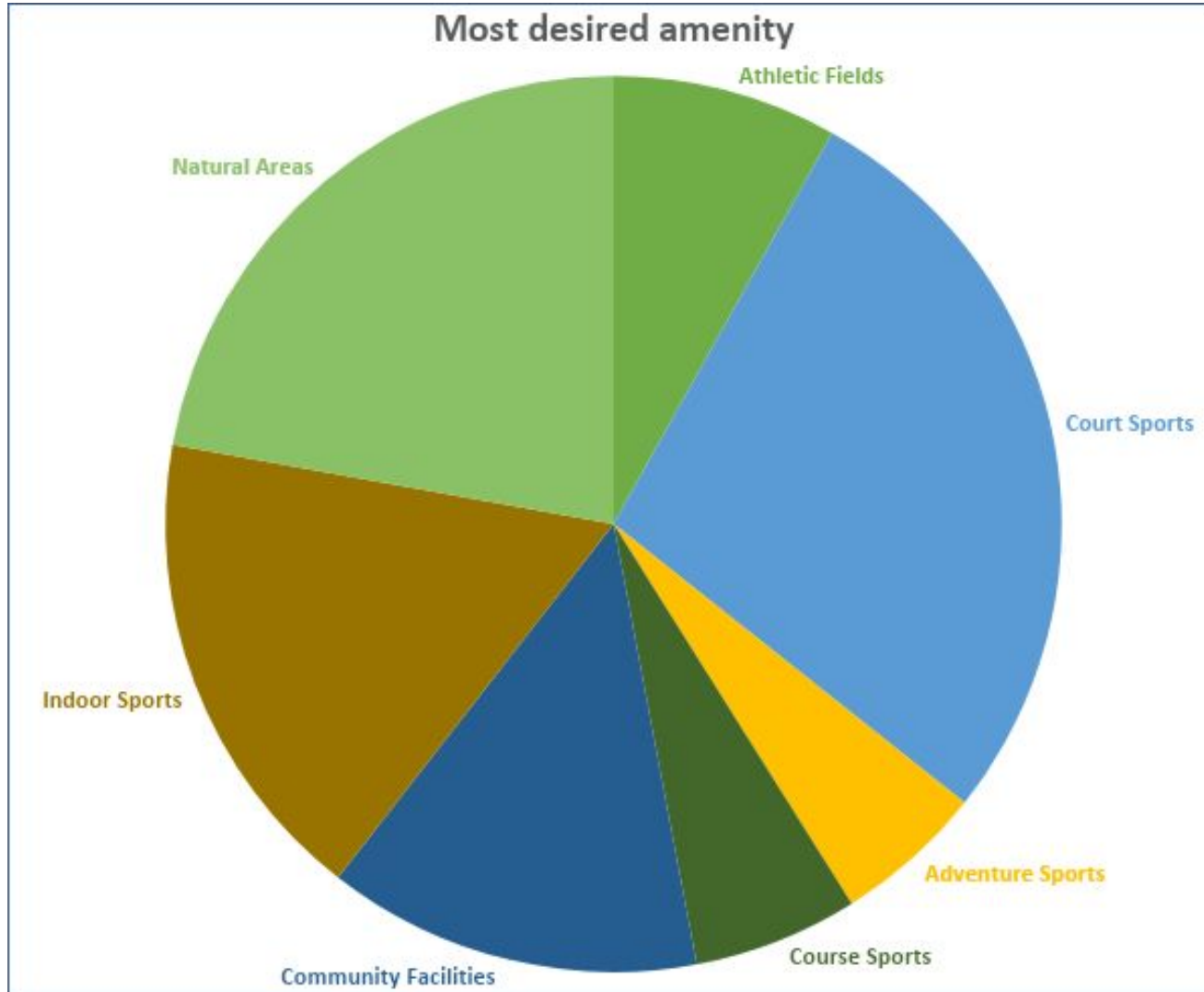

RIVA AREA PARK – 504 responses

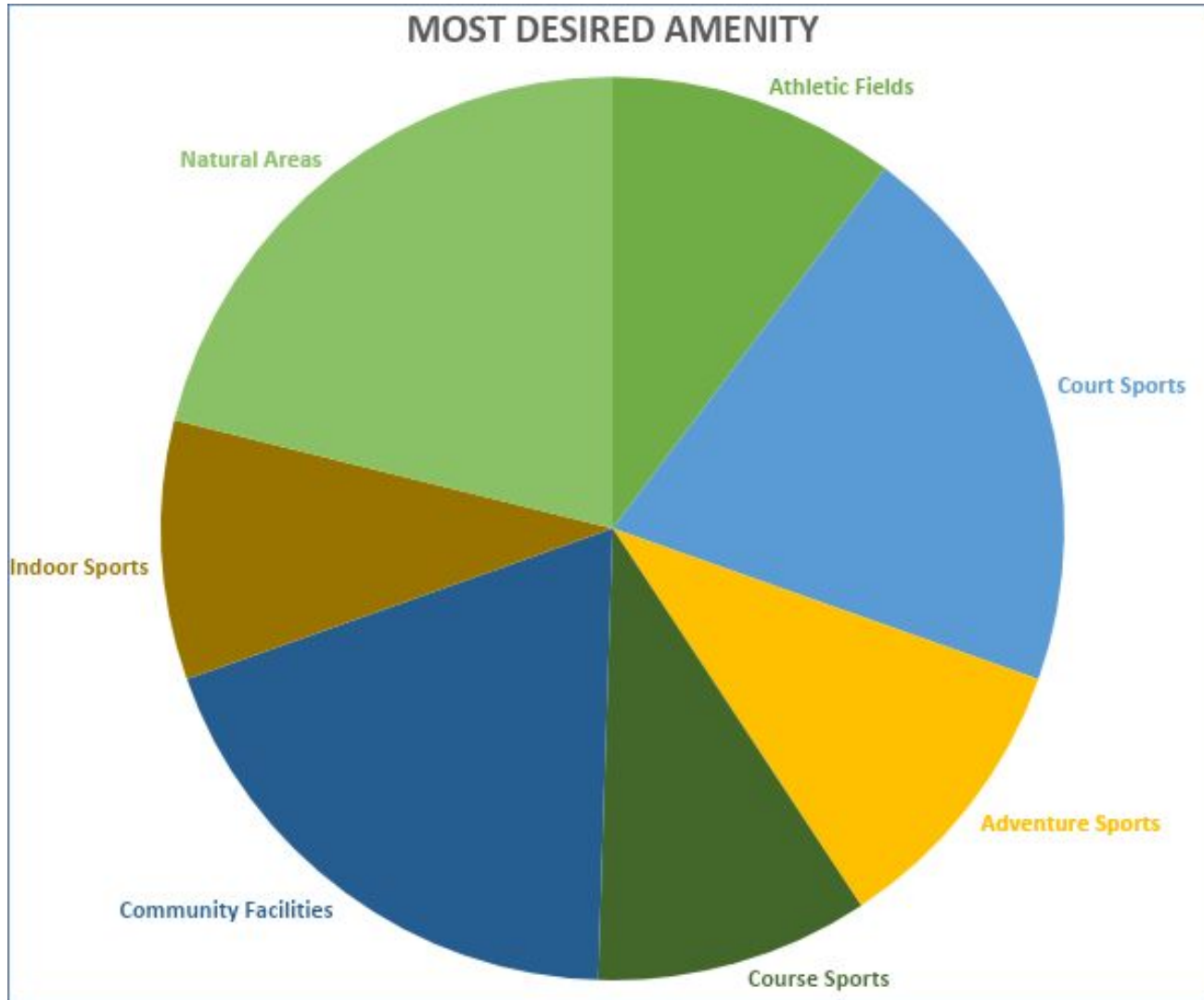

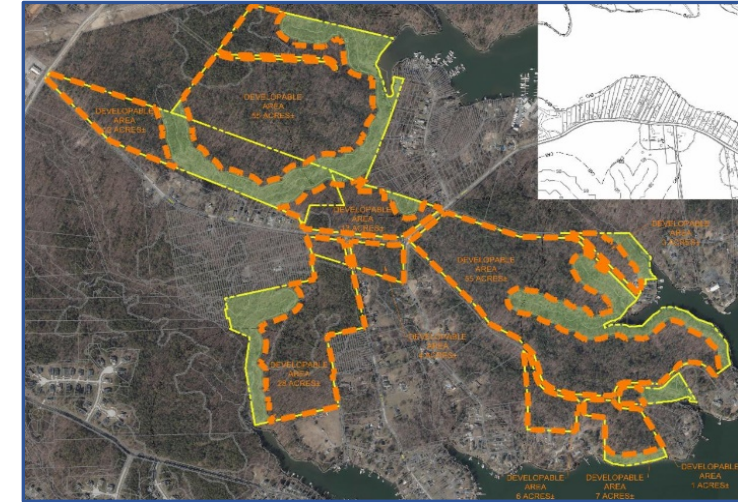

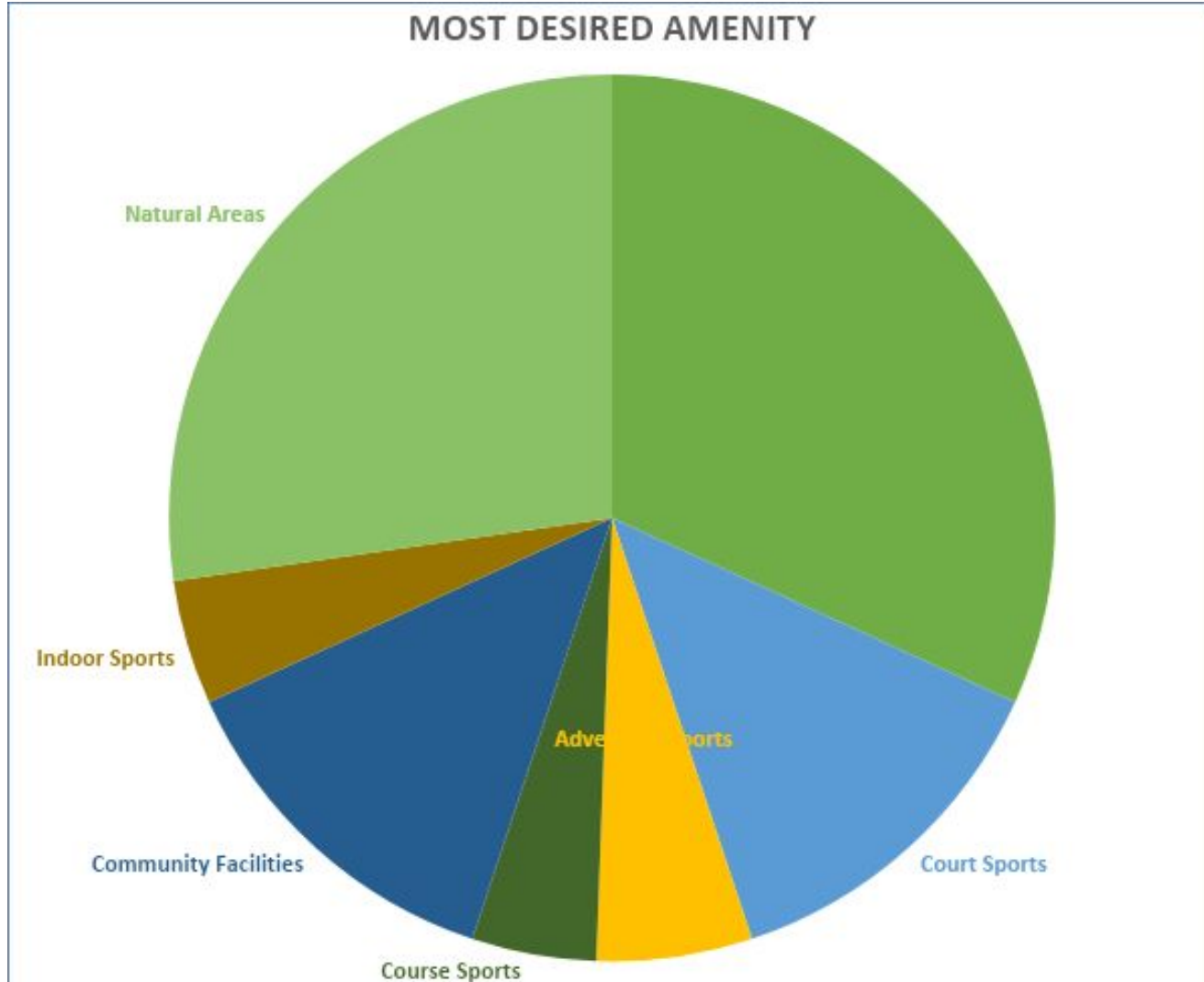

SULLIVAN PARK – 246 responses



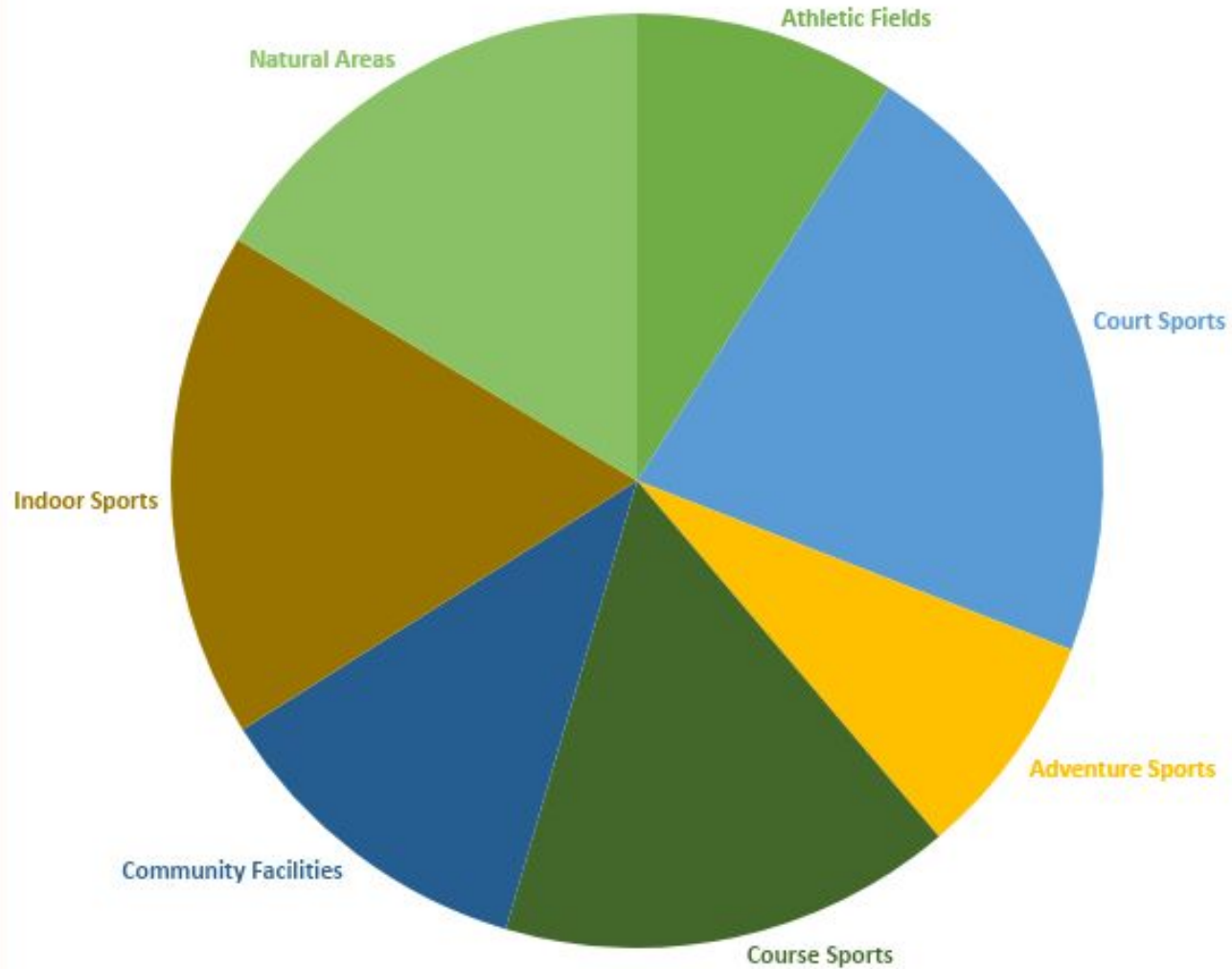
