5	the Chief Administrative Office to the Office of the State's Attorney; and generally		
6	relating to transferring appropriations of funds in the current expense budget for the fiscal

12	authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund;

16	County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,		
17	departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County		
18	government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and

20	WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer of certain funds,		
21	and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for
