A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Capital Budget and Program – Point  
2 Pleasant ES and Annapolis ES – Fund Transfer

3  
4 FOR the purpose of amending the Capital Budget by transferring an appropriation of  
5 funds from the Point Pleasant ES capital project to the Annapolis ES capital project;  
6 making this Ordinance an emergency measure; and amending the Capital Program  
7 and Capital Projects Bond Ordinance.

9 BY amending: Capital Budget  
10 Capital Program  
11 Capital Projects Bond Ordinance

13 WHEREAS, Section 711(b) of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon  
14 request of the County Executive, to transfer appropriations between capital  
15 projects in the Capital Budget and;

16  
17 WHEREAS, § 5-107(b)(1) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of  
18 Maryland requires that expenditures for school building construction be made in  
19 accordance with the cost approved by the County Council for each project; and  
20

21 WHEREAS, § 5-107(b)(2) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of  
22 Maryland provides that transfers between major categories or of unexpended  
23 project balances are subject to the approval of the County Council; and

1 WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting that \$1,000,000 be transferred  
2 from the Point Pleasant ES capital project to the Annapolis ES capital project; and

3  
4 WHEREAS, the Board of Education has requested the transfers; and

5  
6 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available  
7 for appropriation; and

8  
9 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Charter, the County Executive  
10 and the Planning Advisory Board have recommended these amendments to the  
11 Capital Budget; now, therefore,



13 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
14 *Maryland,* That the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, is hereby  
15 amended by transferring appropriations in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the Point  
16 Pleasant ES capital project, Project No. E522100 (County Bonds), to the Annapolis ES  
17 capital project, Project No. E521900 (County Bonds).

18  
19 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Capital Program and Capital Projects  
20 Bond Ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, are hereby amended in  
21 accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.



23 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be  
24 an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
25 peace, health, safety, welfare and property and, being passed by the affirmative vote of  
26 five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes  
27 law.




