A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Classified Service – Public Safety

3 FOR the purpose of modifying the qualifications needed for the position of Police Lieutenant  
4 in the Classified Service; and generally relating to personnel.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 6-1-201(d)(8)  
7 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
10 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

12 **ARTICLE 6. PERSONNEL**

14 **TITLE 1. CLASSIFIED SERVICE**

16 **6-1-201. Titles; pay grades; work weeks; minimum qualifications.**

17  
18 (d) **Title, pay grades, work week, and minimum qualifications.** The title, minimum  
19 standards, pay grade, and the work week designation that an employee is required to follow  
20 for each class within the classified service are as follows:

22 (8) Public Safety and Criminal Justice (PS).

Title	Grade and Work Week	Minimum Qualifications

Police Lieutenant	P3	Graduation from high school; 60 credits of college-level course work or an associate degree[; six] AND FIVE years of experience in progressively responsible police work with the Anne Arundel County Police Department, OR 90 CREDITS OF COLLEGE-LEVEL COURSE WORK AND TWO YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE POLICE WORK WITH THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; with two years of experience in police administration, management, or supervision as an Anne Arundel County police sergeant; and a valid non-commercial Class C motor vehicle operator's license

SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
