9	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,		
10	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

16	6-1-201. Titles; pay grades; work weeks; minimum qualifications.

18	(d) Title, pay grades, work week, and minimum qualifications. The title, minimum		
19	standards, pay grade, and the work week designation that an employee is required to follow		
20	for each class within the classified service are as follows:

22	(8) Public Safety and Criminal Justice (PS).

Police Lieutenant	Р3	Graduation from high school; 60 credits of college- level course work or an associate degree[; six] AND FIVE years of experience in progressively responsible police work with the Anne Arundel County Police Department, OR 90 CREDITS OF COLLEGE-LEVEL COURSE WORK AND TWO YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE POLICE WORK WITH THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; with two years of experience in police administration, management, or supervision as an Anne Arundel County police sergeant; and a valid non-commercial Class C motor vehicle operator's license

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
