Premises for a Senior Housing Project and for facilities ancillary to the operation of 1 the Senior Housing Project; and 2 3 WHEREAS, Cellco Partnership, a Delaware general partnership d/b/a Verizon 4 5 Wireless ("Verizon"), has requested that Bates enter into a Building and Rooftop Lease Agreement ("Verizon Lease") for the purpose of allowing Verizon to install 6 certain communications equipment and antennas at the property; and 7 8 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Verizon Lease, Bates will lease space on the roof of its 9 portion of the Property for the installation, operation, and maintenance of a limited 10 number of antennas; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the County and Bates agrees that Boys and Girls Clubs of Annapolis .13 and Anne Arundel County, Inc., a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of 14 the State of Maryland, shall retain all rental payments and other income resulting 15 from the Verizon Lease; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the County and Bates, are desirous of amending the Lease Agreement 18 dated March 18, 2015 2005, to permit Bates to enter into the Verizon Lease, as set 19 forth in the First Amendment to Lease, incorporated herein by reference as if fully set 20 forth, and a copy of which shall be permanently kept on file in the Office of the 21 Administrative Officer to the County Council and in the Office of Central Services; 22 now, therefore, 23 24 25 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the First Amendment to Lease, which permits Bates School Limited Partnership to enter 26 into a sub-lease with Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless to permit the installation of 27 certain communications equipment and antennas at the Property, is hereby approved. 28 29 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That pursuant to the First Amendment to Lease, 30 Boys and Girls Clubs of Annapolis and Anne Arundel County, Inc., shall be permitted to retain all rental payments and other income resulting from the Verizon Lease. 32 SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law. AMENDMENT ADOPTED: January 19, 2016
