A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: County Executive - Compensation

3 For the purpose of setting the rate of compensation for the County Executive

4
5 WHEREAS, Section 406 of the Charter empowers the County Council, by an
6 affirmative vote of not less than five of its members, to alter the compensation of
7 the County Executive, except for the incumbent County Executive during their
8 current term; and

10 WHEREAS, the salary of the County Executive was most recently set by the
11 County Council in 2006 in Bill No. 23-06 and now stands at \$130,000; and

13 WHEREAS, the Anne Arundel County Personnel Board has submitted a report to
14 the County Council recommending an increase in salary of the County Executive,
15 taking into account the salaries and other compensation of county executives in
16 neighboring jurisdictions of similar size; and

18 WHEREAS, the County Council has reviewed increases in salaries of County
19 Executive in neighboring jurisdictions made contemporaneous or subsequent to
20 the Personnel Board report; now, therefore,

22 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
23 *Maryland,* That under the provision of Section 406 of the Charter, the annual salary for
24 the position of County Executive is hereby established as follows:



9 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
10 from the date it becomes law.






