(d) **Title, pay grades, work week, and minimum qualifications.** The title, minimum standards, pay grade, and the work week designation that an employee is required to follow for each class within the classified service are as follows:

(10) Engineering, Information Technology and Science (SC).

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed to apply retroactively to the first full pay period that began on or after July 1, 2015.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That, in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended), this Ordinance approves an increase of one additional position as an Enterprise Application Manager in the Office of Information Technology and a decrease of one position of Financial Reporting Manager in the Office of Information Technology with respect to the classified positions approved as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
