5 recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Officer as soon as possible after receipt of
6 the September 30th pupil count audited by the State Department of Education, but may be
7 revised more often because of significant changes in enrollments or capacities;

9 (3) shall be based on enrollments projected by the Board of Education and the 10 capacities of schools as determined by the Board of Education under subsections (b) and 11 (c); and

(4) shall determine for each public elementary, middle, and high school whether
the school [has capacity for additional students] ENROLLMENT IS 95% OR LESS OF STATERATED CAPACITY during the third school year after the school year in which the most
recent revision of the school utilization chart is adopted and designate for that year each
public elementary, middle, and high school in the County as "open" IF THE SCHOOL IS AT
95% OR LESS OF STATE-RATED CAPACITY, or "closed" IF THE SCHOOL IS OVER 95% OF
STATE-RATED capacity [based on capacity for additional students].

SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
from the date it becomes law.
