(b) Resolutions.

(2) RESOLUTIONS SUBMITTED FOR INTRODUCTION AT THE REQUEST OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL BE FILED WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER NOT LATER THAN 4:30 P.M. ON THE FIFTH DAY PRIOR TO THE INTENDED INTRODUCTION DATE. THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER SHALL PRESENT THE REQUESTED RESOLUTION TO THE CHAIRMAN. THE CHAIRMAN SHALL INDICATE HIS ACCEPTANCE OR REFUSAL TO INTRODUCE A RESOLUTION SUBMITTED FOR INTRODUCTION AT THE REQUEST OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE BY INFORMING THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER NOT LATER THAN 4:30 P.M. ON THE THIRD DAY PRECEDING THE INTENDED INTRODUCTION DATE. IF THE CHAIRMAN REFUSES TO INTRODUCE A REQUESTED RESOLUTION, A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY SPONSOR THE RESOLUTION FOR INTRODUCTION PROVIDED A SPONSOR FILES A COPY OF THE RESOLUTION WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER NOT LATER THAN NOON TWO DAYS PRIOR TO THE INTENDED INTRODUCTION DATE.
