4 5	FOR the purpose of adopting the "Anne Arundel County Consolidated Plan FY 2016 - FY 2020".
6 7 8 9 l0	WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires that local governments develop Consolidated Plans that identify local housing and community development needs and that further establish goals and strategies to address those needs; and
12 13 14	WHEREAS, an approved Consolidated Plan serves as the framework to identify housing and community development programs that may benefit from HUD grant programs; and
15 16 17 18 19	WHEREAS, under 24 CFR Part 91, local governments are required to submit to HUD for final approval a Consolidated Plan that describes "its plan to pursue these goals for all the community planning and development programs, as well as for housing programs"; and
21 22 23	WHEREAS, the "Anne Arundel County Consolidated Plan FY 2016 - FY 2020" has been drafted to fulfill the requirements of the provisions of 24 CFR Part 91; now, therefore,
.5 :6 :7	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the "Anne Arundel County Consolidated Plan FY 2016 - FY 2020" is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the "Anne Arundel County Consolidated Plan FY 2016 - FY 2020" is incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth, and a certified copy of the "Anne Arundel County Consolidated Plan FY 2016 - FY 2020" shall be permanently kept on file at the Office of the Administrative Officer to the County Council and in the principal office of Arundel Community Development Services, Inc.

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SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
