1	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Public Works - Utilities - Capital
2	Facility Recoupment Charge

4	FOR the purpose of reducing the capital facility recoupment charge; providing for
5	increases in the capital facility recoupment charge to become effective on certain
6	dates; providing that the environmental protection charge not be applied to a capital
7	facility recoupment charge; making this Ordinance an emergency measure; providing
8	for the effective date application of this Ordinance; and generally relating to the
9	capital facility recoupment charge.

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14	SECTION 1. And be it enacted, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code
15	(2005, as amended) read as follows:
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17	ARTICLE 13. PUBLIC WORKS
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19	TITLE 5. UTILITIES

Bill No. 42-16 Page No. 2 13-5-805. Metered water and wastewater charges. (c) Capital facility recoupment charge. (1) There is a capital facility recoupment charge of: [(i) \$2.04; (ii) \$2.33, beginning on July 1, 2012; (iii)\$2.63, beginning on July 1, 2013; (iv) \$2.93, beginning on July 1, 2014; and (v) \$3.22, beginning on July 1, 2015.] (I) \$2.42; (1) (II) \$2.48, BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2016; (III) \$2.54, BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2017; (III) (IV) \$2.60, BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2018; AND (IV) (V) \$2.67, BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2019.

(2) Any residential customer whose water usage exceeds 30,000 gallons in any billing quarter shall be charged, in addition to the usage charges in subsection (b), the capital facility recoupment charge for every full 1,000 gallons of water used in excess of 30,000 gallons.

13-5-808. Environmental fee.

Except in the Mayo Water Reclamation Subdistrict, a 25% environmental protection fee shall be added to all usage charges for both water and wastewater service, EXCEPT FOR THE CAPITAL FACILITY RECOUPMENT CHARGE, to recover costs associated with construction of, expansion of, and improvements to capital facilities to service existing connected customers. Revenues accruing from this fee shall be dedicated for debt service of the water and wastewater utility fund.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall be construed to apply retroactively to March 6, 2016.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2016.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and property and, being passed by the affirmative vote of
