(b) Notice to entities on list. At least two weeks before an appeal that relates to a rezoning, critical area reclassification, or a special exception is heard by the Board of Appeals, the Office of the County Executive shall mail, EITHER BY U.S. POSTAL SERVICE OR BY E-MAIL, to each community association, person, and organization on the list the same information advertised in accordance with § 3-1-202.

(c) To community associations and others. The Office of the County Executive

shall maintain a list of all community associations in the County and of all other persons

and organizations who request to receive the mailing described in this subtitle. At least

provide a copy of the Administrative Hearing Officer's notice of hearing to each

community association, person, and organization on the list that is located in the

Councilmanic District of the property to be affected and any abutting Councilmanic
