## A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Public Works – Permits for Use of County Rights-of-Way
2	<ul> <li>Maintenance Permit and Inspection Fees</li> </ul>

4	FOR the purpose of requiring that a utility be invoiced quarterly for right-of-way
5	maintenance permit and inspection fees; providing that a utility be assessed a penalty
6	on maintenance permit and inspection fees unpaid after 30 days; and generally relating
7	to public works.

15	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,

13-3-306. Maintenance permit and inspection fee due dates; penalties.

A UTILITY SHALL BE BILLED QUARTERLY FOR MAINTENANCE PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES, AND PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE INVOICE. THE OFFICE OF FINANCE SHALL ASSESS A PENALTY CHARGE OF 10% ON MAINTENANCE PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES THAT ARE NOT PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE INVOICE.

(e) Fees. When a utility seeks the issuance of a maintenance permit, it shall pay the

permit and inspection fees required by §§ 13-3-302 and 13-3-303 [[in advance through the

posting of a deposit in an amount estimated by the Director to be sufficient to cover the

required fees. The utility shall replenish the deposit, as required by the Director. Upon notification of activity taken under the maintenance permit, the Director shall deduct from

the deposit the permit and inspection fees required by §§ 13-3-302 and 13-3-303.]] WHEN

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
