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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Grants Special Revenue Fund –  
2 Supplementary Appropriation  
3

4 FOR the purpose of making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated revenues to  
5 the Grants Special Revenue fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.  
6

7 BY amending: Current Expense Budget  
8

9 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the  
10 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from  
11 revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from revenues  
12 received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for the current  
13 fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such funds  
14 are available for appropriation; and

16 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended supplementary appropriations  
17 of revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or revenues received  
18 from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for the current fiscal year;

21 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for  
22 appropriation; now, therefore,

24 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
25 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, be and it is hereby

1 amended by making supplementary appropriations from revenues received from sources not  
2 anticipated in the budget or revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of  
3 budget estimates in the total amount of \$184,500 to the Grants Special Revenue Fund, as  
4 follows:




23 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
