1 2	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning - Commercial Telecommunication Facilities
3 4 5	FOR the purpose of amending certain special exception use requirements for commercial telecommunication facilities located on land owned by a governmental entity or a volunteer fire company; and generally related to zoning

7 8 9	BY repealing and reenacting with amendments: § 18-11-117(1) Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)
10	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,
11 12 13	Maryland, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:
14 15	18-11-117. Commercial telecommunication facilities.
16 17	A commercial telecommunication facility shall comply with all of the following requirements.
18 19 20	(1) A principal structure permanently located on the ground shall be a monopole UNLESS THE PRINCIPAL STRUCTURE IS LOCATED ON LAND OWNED BY A GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY
21 22	OR A VOLUNIEER FIRE COMPANY.
23° 24	SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
