1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Exempt Service – Deputy Director, Aging and
2	Disabilities

4	FOR the purpose of adding a certain position to the exempt service; providing for the pay,
5	pension, and financial disclosure requirements applicable to the position added to the
6	exempt service; providing for the applicability of this Ordinance; approving the decrease
7	of a position in the classified service and an increase of a position in the exempt service;
8	and generally relating to personnel.

9	SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, that, in accordance with §§ 6-1-110 and 6-2-103
10	of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended), this Ordinance shall approve a
11	decrease of one position of Deputy Director, Aging and Disabilities in the Classified Service
12	in the Department of Aging and Disabilities from the positions approved in this classification
13	as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, and an increase in the Exempt
14	Service of one position of Deputy Director, Aging and Disabilities to the positions in the
15	Exempt Service in the Department of Aging and Disabilities approved as part of the Annual
16	Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

18	SECTION 3. 4. And be it further enacted, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply
19	to the first pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2015.
20	
21	SECTION 4. 5. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
22	from the date it becomes law.
