A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Finance, Taxation, and Budget - Subdivision and

FOR the purpose of establishing the Developer Streetlight Special Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purposes of the Fund; requiring that certain fees be paid by certain developers for the purchase, construction, and installation of street lighting; requiring that certain energy and maintenance fees be paid by certain developers for street lighting; establishing a certain payment requirement for certain fees; rescinding an existing fund and transferring the balance; providing for the application of this Ordinance; and generally relating to the Developer Streetlight Special Fund and street lighting.

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BY adding: §§ 4-11-119; and 17-11-301 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 3. Developer Street Light Fee"

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SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

33 34 35	(i) "INSTALLER" MEANS THE PERSON WHO INSTALLS STREET LIGHTING IN A DEVELOPMENT AT THE DIRECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

STREET LIGHTING SHALL BE PLACED IN A LOCATION APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AT THE EXPENSE OF THE DEVELOPER. THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ARRANGING FOR THE PURCHASE, CONSTRUCTION, AND INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTING IN A DEVELOPMENT.
49 50 51	(C) Same – Purchase, construction, and installation fees. A DEVELOPER SHALL PAY A FEE IN THE AMOUNT OF THE ESTIMATED COSTS OF THE PURCHASE, CONSTRUCTION, AND INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTING APPROVED FOR A DEVELOPMENT, BASED ON

THE INSTALLER'S RATES AND CHARGES IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF PAYMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PUBLIC UTILITIES ARTICLE, §§ 4-201, ET SEQ., OF THE STATE CODE, AND THE FEE SHALL INCLUDE THE COUNTY'S OVERHEAD AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. THE FEE PAID BY A DEVELOPER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL BE PLACED INTO THE DEVELOPER STREET LIGHT SPECIAL FUND AND USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 4-11-119 OF THIS CODE.

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(D) Same — Energy and maintenance fees. A DEVELOPER SHALL PAY A FEE IN THE AMOUNT OF THE <u>ESTIMATED</u> COSTS FOR TWO YEARS OF ENERGY AND MAINTENANCE FOR STREET LIGHTING, BASED ON RATES AND CHARGES IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF PAYMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PUBLIC UTILITIES ARTICLE, §§ 4-201, ET SEQ. OF THE STATE CODE.

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15 16 (E) Same – Timing of payment. THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL PROVIDE A DEVELOPER WITH THE AMOUNT OF THE FEES REQUIRED TO BE PAID IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) AND PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE BY THE DEVELOPER AT THE TIME THAT A PUBLIC WORKS AGREEMENT IS EXECUTED.

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22 23 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the special revenue fund that was in existence prior to the enactment of this Ordinance as Fund number 2100, as referenced in Section 17 and Exhibit B in the 2013 2014 Annual Appropriation and Budget Ordinance, Bill Number 46-13, shall cease to exist upon the effective date of this Ordinance and the balance of that fund shall become the starting balance of, and be transferred into, the special revenue fund created by § 4-11-119 as enacted by Section 1 of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall be construed to apply retroactively to July 1, 2013.

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SECTION 4. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
