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Chief of Police, Fire Chief, or Superintendent of Detention Facilities may elect to transfer 1 and become a participant in another plan for which the participant becomes eligible on 2 appointment. The election shall be made within one year of the appointment. A CHIEF OF 3 POLICE OR A FIRE CHIEF WHO UPON APPOINTMENT ELECTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 4 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN MAY ELECT TO TRANSFER BACK TO THE POLICE 5 SERVICE RETIREMENT PLAN ANOTHER RETIREMENT PLAN FOR WHICH THEY ARE 6 ELIGIBLE AT ANY TIME, SO LONG AS THE CHIEF OF POLICE HAS COMPLETED AFTER 7 COMPLETION OF TWENTY YEARS OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE. A SUPERINTENDENT OF 8 DETENTION FACILITIES WHO UPON APPOINTMENT ELECTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 9 10 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN MAY ELECT TO TRANSFER BACK TO THE DETENTION OFFICERS' AND DEPUTY SHERIFFS' RETIREMENT PLAN AFTER COMPLETION OF TEN 11 12 YEARS OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE.

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14 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall 15 take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
