6	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 18-10-111(7)
7	Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)(as amended by Bill No. 14-19)

9	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
10	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)(and as amended by
11	Bill No. 14-19) read as follows:

15	TITLE 10. REQUIREMENTS FOR CONDITIONAL USES

17	18-10-111. Brewery, farm.
18	10 10 111. Divivery, turin.
19	A farm brewery shall comply with all of the following requirements:
20	A faith of ewery shall comply with all of the following requirements.
21	(7) [In an RLD or R1 district,] DIRECT vehicular access shall be located on [a minor]
22	AN arterial or [higher classification] COLLECTOR road and shall be sufficient to prevent
	traffic congestion on roads in adjoining residential areas. NO POINT OF A VEHICULAR
23 24	ACCESS DRIVE MAY BE CLOSER THAN 40 FEET TO THE LOT LINE OF A RESIDENTIALLY
25	ZONED PROPERTY THAT IS NOT PART OF THE FARM BREWERY.
