1 RESOLUTION concerning a determination by the County Council to engage the  
2 services of outside advisors to assist the County Council in certain matters relating to Bill  
3 No. 87-15.

5 WHEREAS, Section 314 of the Anne Arundel County Charter empowers the  
6 County Council, by resolution, to engage the services of experts, consultants or  
7 attorneys to aid in its inquiries, investigations or the drafting and codification of  
8 legislation; and

10 WHEREAS, Bill No. 87-15, introduced by the County Council on July 20, 2015  
11 proposes the creation of the Maryland Live! Conference Center Development  
12 District tax increment development district and the creation of a special tax  
13 increment fund relating to the development district and further authorizes the  
14 issuance of tax increment bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed  
15 \$22,500,000 to be secured by taxes levied on the tax increment in the Maryland  
16 Live! Conference Center Development District; and

18 WHEREAS, the County Council has determined that, because of the complex  
19 nature and effect of the foregoing bill it would be beneficial to have the advice of  
20 independent financial, economic and legal advisors; now, therefore, be it


