(a) Generally. Each member of the Board of Appeals is entitled to an annual salary of \$5,250.

(b) Per diem allowance. In addition to the salary provided in subsection (a), each member is entitled to a per diem allowance of \$75 for each day on which the member incurs necessary travel and incidental expenses while engaged in the discharge of official duties. The allowance is subject to the approval of the [Controller] ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF APPEALS ON A FORM PREPARED BY THE CLERK TO THE BOARD OF APPEALS.
