A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: – Current Expense Budget – Anne
2 Arundel Community College – Transfer of an Appropriation of Funds
3

4 FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds within the Higher Education
5 Fund of the current expense budget; making this Ordinance an emergency measure;
6 and generally relating to transferring an appropriation of funds in the Current Expense
7 Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014.

9 BY amending: Current Expense Budget
10

11 WHEREAS, § 16-301 of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of
12 Maryland, requires that all revenues received by Anne Arundel Community
13 College be submitted for appropriation in accordance with its major functions, as
14 provided under § 16-304(b) of the Education Article, and § 16-304(c) of the
15 Education Article requires that transfers of appropriations between major
16 functions be approved by the County governing body; and

18 WHEREAS, Anne Arundel Community College has requested the transfer of an
19 appropriation of funds between major functions in the Current Expense Budget
20 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the County Executive has approved and
21 recommend the transfer, and the Controller has certified that the appropriation of
22 funds is available for transfer; now, therefore,

24 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
25 *Maryland,* That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, is
26 hereby amended by transferring an appropriation of funds in the amount of \$250,000

1 from the major function designated as Instruction in the Higher Education Fund to the
2 major function designated as Plant Operations in the Higher Education Fund.



4 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
5 an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
6 peace, health, safety, welfare and property and, being passed by the affirmative vote of
7 five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes
8 law.




