A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Transfer of Appropriation – Chief
2 Administrative Office – Fire Department

4 FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds from the Contingency Account of
5 the Chief Administrative Office to the Fire Department; and generally relating to
6 transferring appropriations of funds in the current expense budget for the fiscal year
7 ending June 30, 2016.

9 BY amending: Current Expense Budget

11 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may
12 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund; and

13
14 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the
15 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,
16 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County
17 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and

19 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer of certain funds and
20 the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for appropriation;
21 now, therefore,

23 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
24 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, be and it is hereby
25 amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from the below-listed department in the

7 and by transferring such appropriation of funds to the below-listed department in the
8 respective amount set forth:

10 Fire Department – General Fund Appropriation

14 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from
15 the date that it becomes law.
