22 23	(B) Prohibition. A PERSON MAY NOT OPERATE AN OFF-THE-ROAD MOTORCYCLE
23 24	WITHIN 300 FEET OF A DWELLING WITHOUT THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF $\frac{1}{2}$ AN ADULT RESIDENT OF THE DWELLING.

1 (C) **Sanctions for violations.** A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$75 FOR THE FIRST THREE VIOLATIONS. FOR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATIONS, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, UPON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$250.

5 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
