### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Tax Levy – Idlewilde Shore Erosion  
2 Control District

3  
4 FOR the purpose of modifying the tax levy for the Idlewilde Shore Erosion Control District  
5 for Fiscal Year 2020; and making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

6  
7 WHEREAS, Bill No. 29-19, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for  
8 Fiscal Year 2020, included an appropriation of funds for the Idlewilde Shore  
9 Erosion Control District (“SECD”); and

11 WHEREAS, Bill No. 30-19 included a tax levy for the Idlewilde SECD for Fiscal  
12 Year 2020 in the amount of \$0.211 on each \$100 of assessed valuation of property  
13 within the district to support the appropriation in Bill No. 29-19; and

15 WHEREAS, the tax levy set in Bill No. 30-19 for the Idlewilde SECD for Fiscal  
16 Year 2020 was based on an incorrect calculation of the assessable base within the  
17 district; and

19 WHEREAS, based on the correct calculation of the assessable base within the  
20 district, the tax levy required for the Idlewilde SECD for Fiscal Year 2020 is  
21 \$0.0211; now, therefore,

23 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
24 That the shore erosion control district tax for the Idlewilde SECD for the fiscal year  
25 beginning July 1, 2019, and ending on June 30, 2020, is hereby modified from \$0.211 on

1 each \$100 of assessed valuation of property within the district to \$0.0211 on each \$100 of  
2 assessed valuation of property within the district.


4 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall be construed  
5 retroactively to levy the tax beginning July 1, 2019.

7 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
8 emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
9 health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of five  
10 members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.


