A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Watershed Protection and Restoration Program –  
2 Stormwater Remediation Fee

3  
4 FOR the purpose of providing for a certain phase out of the stormwater remediation fee;  
5 establishing a repeal date for certain stormwater remediation provisions; and  
6 generally related to the Watershed Protection and Restoration Program.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 13-7-103 (o)(1), as amended by Bill  
9 No. 2-15  
10 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11  
12 BY repealing: § 13-7-103 (o)(2), as amended by Bill No. 2-15  
13 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

15 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
16 *Maryland,* That § 13-7-103 (o)(2) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)  
17 and as amended by Bill No. 2-15 is hereby repealed.

19 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That Sections(s) of the Anne Arundel County  
20 Code (2005, as amended) and as amended by Bill No. 2-15 read as follows:

**ARTICLE 13. PUBLIC WORKS**

**TITLE 7. WATERSHED PROTECTION AND RESTORATION PROGRAM**

**13-7-103. Stormwater remediation fee.**

**(o) Implementation of fee.**

[(1) For residential properties, the] THE stormwater remediation fee shall be charged in the following manner:

(i) 60% of the fee beginning in fiscal year 2014;

(ii) 80% of the fee beginning in fiscal year 2015; and

(iii) (1) 100% of the fee beginning in fiscal year 2016 [and each fiscal year thereafter.];

(2) 66% OF THE FEE BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2017;

(3) 33% OF THE FEE BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2018; AND

(4) NO FEE BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2019 AND IN ANY FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER.

**SECTION 3.** *And be it further enacted,* That, effective July 1, 2018, §§ 13-7-101 and 13-7-103 through 13-7-107 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) and as amended by Bill No. 2-15 shall stand repealed with no further action required by the County Council and be of no further force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
