4 FOR the purpose of adding a certain position to the exempt service; providing for the pay,
5 pension, and financial disclosure requirements applicable to the position added to the
6 exempt service; approving the decrease of a position in the classified service and an
7 increase of a position in the exempt service; providing for the applicability of this
8 Ordinance; and generally relating to personnel.

28 ordinance, that may not be changed during a fiscal year except as approved by ordinance of

6 SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, that, in accordance with §§ 6-1-110 and 6-2-103
7 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended), this Ordinance shall approve a
8 decrease of one position of Deputy Central Services Officer in the Classified Service in the
9 Office of Central Services from the positions approved in this classification as part of the
10 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, and an increase in the Exempt Service of one
11 position of Deputy Central Services Officer to the positions in the Exempt Service in the
12 Office of Central Services approved as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation
13 Ordinance.

15 SECTION ~~3~~. 4. *And be it further enacted*, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall
16 apply to the first pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2015.

18 SECTION 4. ~~5~~. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
19 from the date it becomes law.


