### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Public Works – Capital Facility Connection Charges –  
2 Nonprofit Veterans and Military Service Organizations Exemption

3  
4 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination date for the nonprofit veterans and military  
5 service organizations exemption established by Bill No. 109-15 regarding payment of  
6 capital facilities connection charges.

7  
8 BY repealing: Bill No. 109-15, Section 2, Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2015

9  
10 BY renumbering: Bill No. 109-15, Section 3, Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2015 to be  
11 Bill No. 109-15, Section 2, Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2015

13 WHEREAS, Bill No. 109-15, now codified as § 13-5-813(l), established an  
14 exemption for certain structures for nonprofit veterans and military service  
15 organizations from capital facility connection charges; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, Section 2 of Bill No. 109-15 provided that the ordinance was to remain  
18 in effect for five years from the date it became effective, after which it was to be  
19 abrogated and of no further force and effect, with no further action required by the  
20 County Council; and

22 WHEREAS, the exemption established by Bill No. 109-15 is currently set to expire  
23 on January 28, 2021; and

25 WHEREAS, the exemption has been beneficial for veterans and military nonprofits  
26 operating in Anne Arundel County and should continue indefinitely to maintain this  
27 benefit; now, therefore

1 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
2 That Section 2 of Bill No. 109-15 of the Laws of Anne Arundel County of 2015 is hereby  
3 repealed.

4  
5 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That Section 3 of Bill No. 109-15 of the Laws  
6 of Anne Arundel County of 2015 is hereby renumbered to be Section 2 of Bill No. 109-15  
7 of the Laws of Anne Arundel County of 2015.

8  
9 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
10 from the date it becomes law.
