4	FOR the purpose of repealing the termination date for the nonprofit veterans and military
5	service organizations exemption established by Bill No. 109-15 regarding payment of
6	capital facilities connection charges.

13	WHEREAS, Bill No. 109-15, now codified as § 13-5-813(l), established an
14	exemption for certain structures for nonprofit veterans and military service
15	organizations from capital facility connection charges; and

17	WHEREAS, Section 2 of Bill No. 109-15 provided that the ordinance was to remain
18	in effect for five years from the date it became effective, after which it was to be
19	abrogated and of no further force and effect, with no further action required by the
20	County Council; and

22	WHEREAS, the exemption established by Bill No. 109-15 is currently set to expire
23	on January 28, 2021; and

25	WHEREAS, the exemption has been beneficial for veterans and military nonprofits
26	operating in Anne Arundel County and should continue indefinitely to maintain this
27	benefit; now, therefore
