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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Stormwater Remediation Fee – Property Tax Notice

2  
3 FOR the purpose of amending the real property tax notice provision regarding the  
4 Stormwater Remediation Fee to conform with State law; and generally related to the  
5 Stormwater Remediation Fee.

7 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments: § 13-7-103(p)  
8 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)  
9

10 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
11 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as  
12 follows:

14 **ARTICLE 13. PUBLIC WORKS**

16 **TITLE 7. WATERSHED PROTECTION AND RESTORATION PROGRAM**

18 **13-7-103. Stormwater remediation fee.**  
19

20 (p) **Collection.** The stormwater remediation fee shall be billed annually to the owner  
21 of the real property on which it is imposed. The stormwater remediation fee shall be  
22 collected as provided in § 1-9-101 of this Code. The Controller shall include an  
23 explanation in each property tax bill that [indicates that the stormwater remediation fee  
24 included on the property tax bill is a tax required by Maryland House Bill 987, enrolled

1 as Chapter 151 of the Acts of the General Assembly, 2012, which was passed by the  
2 General Assembly and signed into law by the Governor on May 2, 2012, and is now  
3 codified as § 4.202.1(e) of the Environment Article of the State Code] STATES  
4 "PURSUANT TO §4-202.1(H)(1)(II) OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE OF THE STATE CODE,  
5 THE STORMWATER REMEDIATION FEE IS A LOCAL GOVERNMENT FEE ESTABLISHED IN  
6 RESPONSE TO FEDERAL STORMWATER MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS. THE FEDERAL  
7 REQUIREMENTS ARE DESIGNED TO PREVENT LOCAL SOURCES OF POLLUTION FROM  
8 REACHING LOCAL WATERWAYS."  
9

10 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall  
11 take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.




