BILL: AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING: PUBLIC WORKS – COUNTY RIGHTS-OF-WAY – ZONING – SMALL CELL SYSTEMS

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

The purpose of this Ordinance is to define “small cell systems” for County right-of-way permits, establish and modify certain requirements for small cell systems locating in the County right-of way, establishing fees for permits for small cell systems in County right-of way and generally related to public works and zoning.

FISCAL IMPACT

Generally, there will not be a fiscal impact as the County sets aggregate permit fees to cover the cost associated with the permitting and inspections of certain activities. The County can potentially receive revenues by installing small cell systems on the County right-of-way or existing structure and leasing them out to telecommunication companies. The overall fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate at this point as we don't know how many small cell systems are going to be installed and how much revenues are going to be generated.
