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10	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
11	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:
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13	ARTICLE 18. ZONING
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TITLE 4. RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS

18-4-106. Permitted, conditional, and special exception uses.

The permitted, conditional, and special exception uses allowed in each of the residential districts are listed in the chart in this section using the following key: P = permitted use; C = conditional use; SE = special exception use. A blank means that the use is not allowed in the district. Except as provided otherwise in this article, uses and structures customarily accessory to the listed uses also are allowed, except that guest houses as accessory structures are prohibited and outside storage as an accessory use is limited to

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the lesser of 10% of the allowed lot coverage or 500 square feet.

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SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall apply to any workforce housing development for which a special exception has not been granted as of December 1, 2014.

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SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days after it becomes law.
