1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Construction and Property Maintenance Codes
2	Supplement – Permits – Residential Piers and Riparian Rights

4	FOR the purpose of requiring an application for construction of a residential pier to include
5	a certain certification of ownership of riparian rights; requiring that notice of the
6	application be sent to certain interested parties; and generally relating to construction
7	and property maintenance codes.

9	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: Construction Code, Chapter 1, § 105.3.1
10	Anne Arundel County Construction and Property Maintenance Codes Supplement,
11	October 1, 2005 (as amended)

13	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
14	That the Anne Arundel County Construction and Property Maintenance Codes
15	Supplement, October 1, 2005 (as amended) read as follows:

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7	105.3 Application for permit. To obtain a permit, the applicant shall first file an
8	application in writing on a form furnished by the Department for that purpose.
9	
10	105.3.1 Such application shall:
11	
12	105.3.1.1 Identify and describe the work to be covered by the permit for which
13	application is made;
14	upplication is made,
15	105.3.1.2 Describe the land on which the proposed work is to be done by legal
	description, street address, or similar description that will readily identify and definitely
16	
17	locate the proposed building or work;
18	
19	105.3.1.3 Indicate the use and occupancy for which the proposed work is intended;
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21	105.3.1.4 Be accompanied by construction documents and other information as
22	required in Section 106;

24	105.3.1.5 State the valuation of the proposed work;
25	
26	105.3.1.6 Be signed by the owner, or the owner's authorized agent; [[and]]

28	105.3.1.7 IF THE APPLICATION IS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A RESIDENTIAL PIER,
29	INCLUDE A CERTIFICATION THAT THE APPLICANT OWNS RIPARIAN RIGHTS AND THAT THE
30	COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED DOES NOT OWN RIPARIAN RIGHTS FOR
31	THE SUBJECT LOT, OR ANY LAND, LOTS, OR PARCELS ABUTTING THE SUBJECT LOT, AND
32	SHALL INCLUDE COPIES OF ANY RECORDED INSTRUMENTS SUPPORTING THE
33	CERTIFICATION; AND
34	1052151 CHALL CEDTEN THAT NOTICE WAS SENT DV CEDTEED OD
35 36	105.3.1.7.1 SHALL CERTIFY THAT NOTICE WAS SENT, BY CERTIFIED OR ELECTRONIC MAIL, TO ANY HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION THAT GOVERNS THE PROPERTY
30 37	THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE APPLICATION, NOTIFYING THE ASSOCIATION THAT AN
38	APPLICATION HAS BEEN FILED FOR A RESIDENTIAL PIER, OR, IF THE APPLICANT CERTIFIES
39	THAT CONTACT INFORMATION FOR THE HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION WAS NOT
40	AVAILABLE, A CERTIFICATION THAT PROPERTY OWNERS OF ALL PROPERTY ABUTTING
41	THE APPLICANT'S PROPERTY WERE SENT THE NOTICE; AND

43	[[105.3.1.7]] 105.3.1.8 Give such other data and information as required by the Code
44	Official.

46	SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
47	from the date it becomes law.
