## A BILL ENTITLED

1 2	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Additional Appropriations
3	
4	FOR the purpose of making additional appropriations of funds from revenues received from
5	anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates to the Chief Administrative Officer
6	and the Fire Department; making this ordinance an emergency measure; and generally
7	relating to additional appropriations of funds in the current expense budget for the fiscal
8	year ending June 30, 2013.

10	BY amending: Current Expense Budget
11	
12	WHEREAS, Section 712 of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon
13	recommendation of the County Executive, to make additional appropriations from
14	revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for the
15	current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such
16	funds are available for appropriation; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, the County has received funds from anticipated sources in excess of
19	budget estimates in the amount of \$5,500,000 \$6,400,000; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended additional appropriation of
22	these funds to the Chief Administrative Officer and the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for 1 2 appropriation; now, therefore, 3 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, 4 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, be and it is hereby 5 amended by appropriating revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget 6 estimates in the amounts set forth to the following accounts: 7 8 9 Chief Administrative Officer Management & Control 10 Grants, Contributions & Other \$ 500,000 \$ 1,400,000 11 12 13 Fire Department Planning & Logistics 14 Contractual Services 500,000 15 16 17 Fire Department Operations 18 \$4,500,000 19 Personal Services 20 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an 21 emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, 22 health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of five members 23 of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law. 24 AMENDMENT ADOPTED: June 3, 2013 READ AND PASSED this 3rd day of June, 2013 By Order: Elizabeth E.
