10	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,
11	Maryland, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as

19	The County Council shall levy property taxes ON OR before [June 1] JUNE 15 JUNE 30

23	SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
24	an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25	peace, health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of
