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4 FOR the purpose of amending the process for monitoring and revising the General  
5 Development Plan for Anne Arundel County; and generally relating to zoning.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 18-2-104(f)  
8 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

10 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
11 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as

18 **18-2-104. Planning for future development.**

20 (f) **Review.** The Office of Planning and Zoning continually shall monitor the  
21 effectiveness of the General Development Plan in accomplishing its function and shall  
22 prepare and provide to the Council an annual report that conforms with State  
23 requirements for annual comprehensive plan reports. At intervals not to exceed [ten]  
24 EIGHT years, the Office of Planning and Zoning shall undertake a comprehensive review  
25 of the General Development Plan and its implementing mechanisms and shall  
26 recommend those revisions to the Plan and implementing mechanisms as are necessary



5 from the date it becomes law.


