4 FOR the purpose of establishing that special community benefit districts may be formed in  
5 residential and non-residential areas of the County; and generally relating to special  
6 community benefit districts.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 4-7-202(a)  
9 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
12 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

16 **TITLE 7. SPECIAL COMMUNITY BENEFIT DISTRICTS, SHORE EROSION**

19 **4-7-202. Procedure for establishment of district.**

21 (a) **By County Council.** The County Council may establish special community benefit  
22 districts FOR RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL AREAS in the County, furnish and provide  
23 special privileges or benefits to persons or property in the districts, and levy special taxes on


1 property in the districts receiving the special benefit to pay the costs of furnishing, providing,


4 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days




