A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Capital Budget and Program – Sudley CC  
2 Upgrade – Fund Transfer

3  
4 FOR the purpose of amending the Capital Budget by transferring an appropriation of  
5 funds from the Cell 9 Disposal Area capital project to the Sudley CC Upgrade capital  
6 project; amending the Capital Program and Capital Projects Bond Ordinance; and  
7 making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

9 BY amending: Capital Budget  
10 Capital Program  
11 Capital Projects Bond Ordinance

13 WHEREAS, the Sudley CC Upgrade capital project, Project No. N542500, has an  
14 existing appropriation; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, Section 716 of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon  
17 request of the County Executive and by the affirmative vote of five members of the  
18 County Council, to amend the capital budget; and

20 WHEREAS, Section 711(b) of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon  
21 request of the County Executive, to transfer appropriations between capital  
22 projects in the Capital Budget; and

1 WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting that \$60,000 be transferred from  
2 the Cell 9 Disposal Area capital project, Project No. N530600, to the Sudley CC  
3 Upgrade capital project, Project No. N542500; and

4  
5 WHEREAS, the Planning Advisory Board has recommended these amendments to  
6 the Capital Budget in accordance with Section 716 of the Charter; and

7  
8 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for  
9 appropriation; and

10  
11 WHEREAS, Section 307(i) of the Charter authorizes the County Council to  
12 increase the funding for capital projects by emergency ordinance so long as the  
13 increases are required solely to meet cost escalation and do not affect the scope of  
14 the project, and the County Council has determined these criteria to be met; now  
15 therefore,

16  
17 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
18 *Maryland,* that the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, is hereby  
19 amended by transferring appropriations in the amount of \$60,000 from the Cell 9 Disposal  
20 Area capital project, Project No. N530600 (Solid Waste Bonds), to the Sudley CC  
21 Upgrade capital project, Project No. N542500 (Solid Waste Bonds).

22  
23 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Capital Program and Capital Projects  
24 Bond Ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, are hereby amended in  
25 accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.



27 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be  
28 an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
29 health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of five  
30 members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
