A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Capital Budget and Program – Septic System Enhancements  
2 – Amending Scope and Description of Project

3  
4 FOR the purpose of amending the Capital Budget by amending the scope and description of  
5 the Septic System Enhancements capital project; amending the Capital Program and  
6 Capital Projects Bond Ordinance; and generally relating to the Septic System  
7 Enhancements capital project.

9 BY amending: Capital Budget  
10 Capital Program  
11 Capital Projects Bond Ordinance

13 WHEREAS, Section 716 of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon request  
14 of the County Executive and by affirmative vote of five members of the County  
15 Council to amend the capital budget; and  
16

17 WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting that the scope and description of the  
18 Septic System Enhancements capital project, Capital Project No. C537700 be  
19 amended to include subsidizing the cost of connecting certain properties to public  
20 sewer under certain circumstances, as permitted by Maryland law; and

22 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Charter, the Planning Advisory  
23 Board has recommended this amendment to the Capital Budget; now, therefore,


1 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
2 That the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, is hereby amended by  
3 revising the scope and description of the Septic System Enhancements capital project, Capital  
4 Project No. C537700, to state: "This project will provide financial incentives, through grant  
5 subsidies, to property owners for the cost of upgrading conventional on-site sewage disposal  
6 systems to nitrogen reducing technology, and to subsidize the cost to connect to public sewer  
7 as authorized under the Annotated Code of Maryland, Environment Article § 9-1605.2(h).  
8 Grant from the Maryland Chesapeake Bay Restoration Program."

9  
10 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Capital Program and Capital Projects  
11 Bond Ordinance are hereby amended in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.






