A BILL ENTITLED

FOR the purpose of obtaining approval to increase and decrease the number of positions in certain classifications in the classified service; providing for the applicability of this

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Position Control in the Classified Service

Ordinance, and generally relating to the classified service.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase of eighty-eight Fire Fighter II, six Fire Fighter III, one Fire Fighter/Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic, fifteen Fire Lieutenants, and three Fire Captain positions in the Fire Department from the number of positions approved in these classifications as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of one Construction Inspection Supervisor and six Construction Inspector positions in the Department of Inspections and Permits approved in these classifications as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase of one Environmental Control Inspection Supervisor and six Environmental Control Inspector positions in the Department of Inspections and Permits approved in these classifications as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

SECTION 8. And be it further enacted, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of two Detention Officers in the Department of Detention Facilities approved in this classification as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

SECTION 9. And be it further enacted, That in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) this Ordinance shall approve an increase of one Detention Sergeant and one Detention Captain in the Department of Detention Facilities approved in these classifications as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

SECTION 10. And be it further enacted, That changes to position control under Sections 1 through 9 of this Ordinance shall take effect at the beginning of the first full pay period on or after the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
