Council. ANY ADDITIONAL EXTENSIONS AUTHORIZED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY NOT EXCEED 45 DAYS IN DURATION.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to a proclamation of a civil emergency made by a County Executive, and any executive order entered pursuant to the aforementioned proclamation of a civil emergency, on or after the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2.3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
