4 2013 as one of the documents used to guide the future development of land and the  
5 location of public services and facilities in the County; and generally relating to the  
6 Solid Waste Management Plan 2013.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 18-2-103 (a)(5)(vii)  
9 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. *And be it further enacted*, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County  
12 Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

4 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the Anne Arundel County Solid Waste  
5 Management Plan 2013 is incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth. A copy  
6 of the Anne Arundel County Solid Waste Management Plan 2013 shall be permanently  
7 kept on file with the Administrative Officer of the County Council, the Office of  
8 Planning and Zoning, and the Department of Public Works.

10 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
11 from the date it becomes law.




