AT THE DISCRETION OF THE DIRECTOR <u>AND UPON APPLICATION OF THE PROPERTY OWNER</u> , THE COUNTY MAY SUBSIDIZE <u>THE PER-PROPERTY PROJECT COST FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES WITH EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS LOCATED IN A WASTEWATER EXTENSION PROJECT <del>LOCATED</del> IN AN ELIGIBLE AREA., NOT TO EXCEED 25% OF THE TOTAL PROJECT COST. THE SUBSIDY MAY BE:</u>

50	(3) ENGINEERING CONSIDERATIONS;

53 54	(5) THE FINANCIAL VIABILITY OF THE WASTEWATER EXTENSION PROJECT; AND

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
