5-1-209. Credited pre-plan military service.

(a) Generally. A participant may receive a maximum of three years of credited pre-plan military service for active duty pre-plan military service honorably completed before employment with an employer if:

(1) for a participant in the Fire Service Retirement Plan or the Police Service Retirement Plan, the participant completes actual plan service plus transferred service under § 5-1-304 totaling 20 years;

(2) [for a participant in the Employees' Retirement Plan] FOR A CATEGORY I PARTICIPANT OR A CATEGORY II PARTICIPANT HIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 2015, IN THE DETENTION OFFICERS' AND DEPUTY SHERIFFS' RETIREMENT PLAN, the participant completes actual plan service plus transferred service under § 5-1-302 totaling five years; [or]

(1) To obtain purchased service, a participant shall pay a lump sum amount equal to the reserves actuarially determined necessary to fund the benefits attributable to the purchased service.

(2) [Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, a participant] A CATEGORY I PARTICIPANT AND A CATEGORY II PARTICIPANT HIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 2015, IN THE DETENTION OFFICERS' AND DEPUTY SHERIFFS' RETIREMENT PLAN may not obtain and pay

for any purchased service until the participant has completed actual plan service plus transferred service under § 5-1-302 totaling five years.

(3) A CATEGORY II PARTICIPANT IN THE DETENTION OFFICERS' AND DEPUTY SHERIFFS' RETIREMENT PLAN HIRED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2015 MAY NOT OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ANY PURCHASED SERVICE UNTIL THE PARTICIPANT HAS COMPLETED ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-302 TOTALING 10 YEARS.

(4) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION, A PARTICIPANT IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN HIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 2015, MAY NOT OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ANY PURCHASED SERVICE UNTIL THE PARTICIPANT HAS COMPLETED ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-302 TOTALING FIVE YEARS.

(5) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION, A PARTICIPANT IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN HIRED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2015 MAY NOT OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ANY PURCHASED SERVICE UNTIL THE PARTICIPANT HAS COMPLETED ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-302 TOTALING 10 YEARS.

(6) A PARTICIPANT IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN WHO IS AN ELECTED OFFICIAL WHOSE FIRST TERM BEGINS ON OR AFTER DECEMBER 1, 2014 MAY NOT OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ANY PURCHASED SERVICE UNTIL THE PARTICIPANT HAS COMPLETED ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-302 TOTALING 10 YEARS.

## TITLE 3. EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN

# 5-3-301. Vesting; termination of service before retirement.

(a) Generally. A participant vests in the benefits of the plan upon completion of actual plan service plus transferred service under § 5-1-302 [totaling five years] AS SET FORTH IN THIS SUBSECTION.

(1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION, A PARTICIPANT IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN HIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 2015 VESTS IN THE BENEFITS OF THE PLAN UPON COMPLETION OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER  $\S$  5-1-302 TOTALING FIVE YEARS.

(2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBSECTION, A PARTICIPANT IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN HIRED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2015 VESTS IN THE BENEFITS OF THE PLAN UPON COMPLETION OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER  $\S$  5-1-302 TOTALING 10 YEARS.

(3) A PARTICIPANT IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN WHO IS AN ELECTED OFFICIAL A COUNTY COUNCILMEMBER WHOSE FIRST TERM BEGINS ON OR AFTER DECEMBER 1, 2014 VESTS IN THE BENEFITS OF THE PLAN UPON COMPLETION OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-302 TOTALING 10 YEARS.

#### 5-3-302. Determination of normal retirement date and early retirement date.

- (a) Normal retirement date. A participant's normal retirement date is the first day of the month coinciding with or next following the earlier of:
- (1) FOR A PARTICIPANT HIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 1999, THE PARTICIPANT'S 60TH BIRTHDAY OR THE COMPLETION OF 30 YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE.
- [(1)] (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, for a participant hired on or after July 1, 1999 AND BEFORE JULY 1, 2015:

(i) the participant's 60th birthday and completion of actual plan service plus transferred service under § 5-1-302 totaling five years; or

(ii) the completion of 30 years of credited service.[; or

(2) for a participant hired before July 1, 1999, the participant's 60th birthday or the completion of 30 years of credited service.]

(3) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, FOR A PARTICIPANT HIRED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2015:

(I) THE PARTICIPANT'S 60TH BIRTHDAY AND COMPLETION OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-303 TOTALING 10 YEARS; OR

(II) THE COMPLETION OF 30 YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE.

(4) FOR A PARTICIPANT IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN WHO IS AN ELECTED OFFICIAL A COUNTY COUNCILMEMBER WHOSE FIRST TERM BEGINS ON OR AFTER **DECEMBER 1, 2014:** 

(I) THE PARTICIPANT'S 60TH BIRTHDAY AND COMPLETION OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-303 TOTALING 10 YEARS; OR

- (b) Non-service-connected disability retirement pension. A participant who is not eligible to retire on a normal retirement pension may be retired by the Personnel Officer on a non-service-connected disability retirement pension beginning on the date the following conditions are met:
- (1) the Personnel Officer determines, on the basis of a medical examination by one or more physicians selected by the Personnel Officer, that the participant has a total and permanent disability in that the participant is wholly and permanently prevented, as a result of bodily injury or disease, but not as a result of bodily injury or occupational disease incurred in the performance of duty, from engaging in an occupation or employment for remuneration or profit or continuing in the capacity of an employee;
- (2) the participant has exhausted all accrued disability leave and all accident and sickness benefits from programs, exclusive of federal Social Security, to which the County makes contributions;
- (3) for a tier one employee, the participant was making employee contributions under this title immediately prior to the participant's date of disability;
- (4) the participant has [five years of actual plan service] VESTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5-3-301;
  - (5) the participant is not eligible for a service-connected disability retirement; and
  - (6) the participant is eligible for disability benefits under the Social Security Act.

# TITLE 6. DETENTION OFFICERS' AND DEPUTY SHERIFFS' RETIREMENT PLAN

5-6-201. Vesting; termination of service before retirement.

(a) Generally.

(1) A category I participant hired on or after August 9, 2004 vests in the benefits of the plan upon completion of 20 years of actual plan service.

- (2) A category I participant hired before August 4, 2004 and a category II participant HIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 2015 vest in the benefits of the plan upon completion of actual plan service plus transferred service under § 5-1-302 totaling five years.
- (3) A CATEGORY II PARTICIPANT HIRED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2015 VESTS IN THE BENEFITS OF THE PLAN UPON COMPLETION OF ACTUAL PLAN SERVICE PLUS TRANSFERRED SERVICE UNDER § 5-1-302 TOTALING 10 YEARS.
- 5-6-202. Determination of normal retirement date and early retirement date.
- (b) Normal retirement date for category II participants. The normal retirement date for a category II participant is:
