### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Special Community Benefit Districts – General  
2 Provisions – Special Police

3  
4 FOR the purpose of providing that special police officers meeting certain criteria may be  
5 employed to patrol a special community benefit district; and generally related to  
6 special community benefit districts.

8 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments: § 4-7-201(c)  
9 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
12 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as  
13 follows:

#### ARTICLE 4. FINANCE, TAXATION AND BUDGET

#### TITLE 7. SPECIAL COMMUNITY BENEFIT DISTRICTS, SHORE EROSION CONTROL DISTRICTS, AND WATERWAYS IMPROVEMENTS DISTRICTS

##### 4-7-201. General provisions.

22 (c) **Special police officers.** If a special community benefit district includes a special  
23 police officer within its purpose, the officer is not an agent, servant, or employee of the  
24 County unless acting directly under the supervision of a regular full-time patrolman or  
25 officer of the Police Department. IF THE PURPOSE OF A DISTRICT INCLUDES SECURITY

1 PATROLS OR THE PROTECTION OF COMMUNITY, PRIVATE, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY WITHIN  
2 A DISTRICT BY SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS, SUCH SECURITY OR PROTECTION MAY BE  
3 PROVIDED BY SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS COMMISSIONED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE  
4 PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE OF THE STATE CODE, REGULAR POLICE OFFICERS ON  
5 SECONDARY EMPLOYMENT, OR CERTIFIED SECURITY GUARDS EMPLOYED BY A  
6 SECURITY GUARD AGENCY LICENSED BY THE STATE OF MARYLAND.


8 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
9 from the date it becomes law.


