PATROLS OR THE PROTECTION OF COMMUNITY, PRIVATE, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY WITHIN
A DISTRICT BY SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS, SUCH SECURITY OR PROTECTION MAY BE
PROVIDED BY SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS COMMISSIONED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE OF THE STATE CODE, REGULAR POLICE OFFICERS ON
SECONDARY EMPLOYMENT, OR CERTIFIED SECURITY GUARDS EMPLOYED BY A
SECURITY GUARD AGENCY LICENSED BY THE STATE OF MARYLAND.
