1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Construction and Property Maintenance Codes – Right of
2 Entry – Health Department

4 FOR the purpose of removing a requirement that the Health Officer keep confidential any
5 unrelated evidence found during the course of an onsite inspection; and generally
6 relating to construction and property maintenance codes.

8 BY repealing § 15-1-104(e)
9 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
12 *Maryland,* That § 15-1-104(e) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) is
13 hereby repealed.

15 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County
16 Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

20 21 **TITLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

23 **15-1-104. Right of entry – Health Department.**

1 [(e)**Unrelated evidence found on inspection.** The Health Officer shall keep
2 confidential all evidence not related to the purposes of Title 4 that is discovered in the
3 course of an inspection under Title 4.]
