County Construction and Property Maintenance Codes Supplement, October 1, 2005 (as amended) are hereby renumbered to be <u>the International Residential Code Amendments</u>, <u>Items 25 through 34; and the International Plumbing Code Amendments</u>, Items (9) through (19), respectively.

SECTION 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the Anne Arundel County Construction and Property Maintenance Codes Supplement, October 1, 2005, reads as follows:

CONSTRUCTION AND PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODES SUPPLEMENT

INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE AMENDMENTS.

(24) AFTER SECTION P2503.8 INSERT:

<u>P2503.8.1 Inspections</u>. Inspections shall be made of all backflow prevention assemblies UPON INSTALLATION, IMMEDIATELY AFTER REPAIRS OR RELOCATION, AND EVERY THREE YEARS to determine whether they are operable.

P2503.8.2 Testing. Reduced pressure principle, double check, double check detector and pressure vacuum breaker backflow assemblies shall be tested at the time of installation, immediately after repairs or relocation and [at least annually] EVERY THREE YEARS.

PLUMBING CODE AMENDMENTS

The provisions of the 2012 International Plumbing Code are amended, deleted, or corrected as follows and the following provisions shall supersede the part of the text of the 2012 International Plumbing Code as indicated:

(8) IN SECTION 312.10.1 312.10 IN THE FIRST SENTENCE, STRIKE THE "AND" AND SUBSTITUTE A COMMA, IN THE SAME SENTENCE, AFTER "312.10.2" INSERT "AND 312.10.3" AND, AFTER THE THIRD PARAGRAPH, INSERT:

"312.10.3 EXCEPTIONS. INSPECTIONS <u>AND TESTING</u> OF BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLIES AND AIR GAPS IN SINGLE FAMILY DETACHED DWELLINGS, SEMI-DETACHED DWELLINGS, TOWNHOMES AND RESIDENTIAL IRRIGATION SYSTEMS SHALL BE MADE EVERY THREE YEARS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THEY ARE OPERABLE."

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
